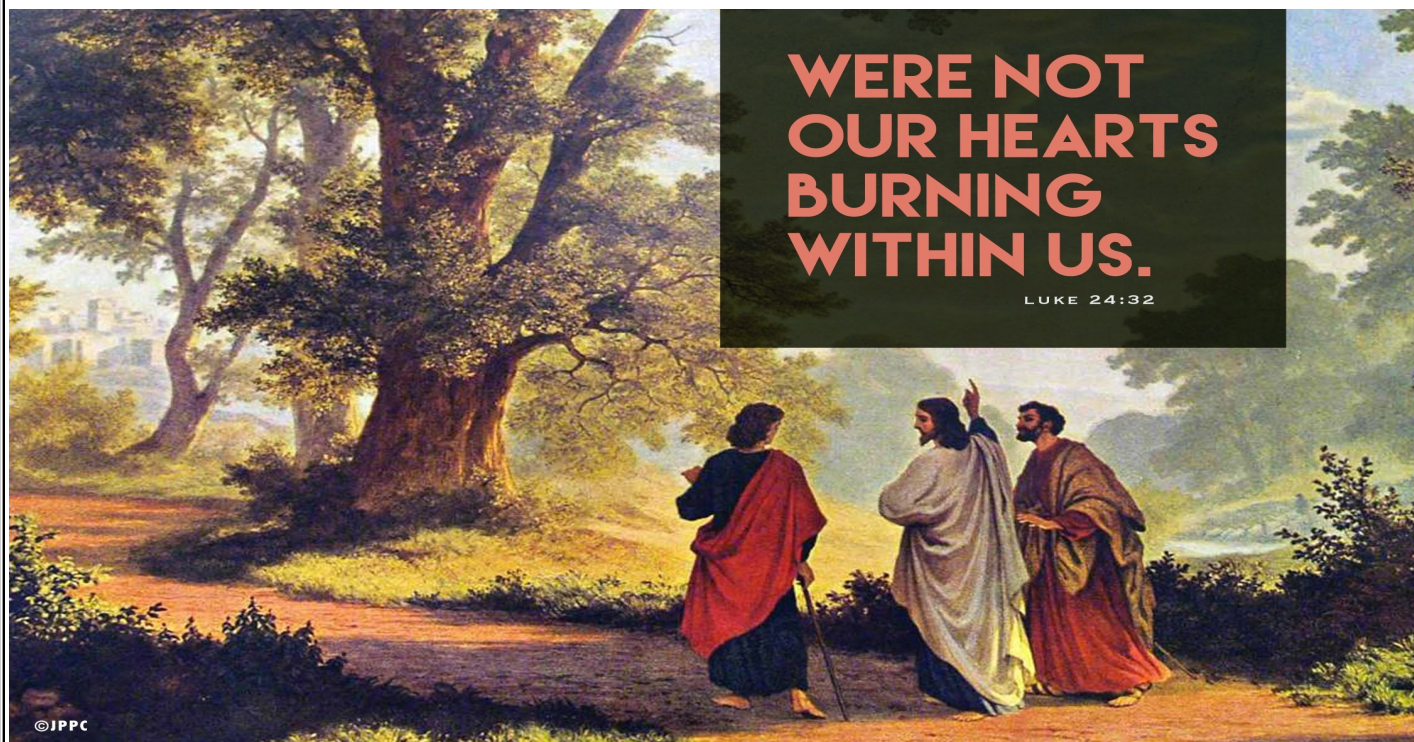

MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of April 16, 2023, we have received \$201,460.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. To date, we have spent \$172,745.40 on renovations including an enlarged office for the Director of Religious Education, several enlarged rooms for youth gatherings, new HVAC throughout both sides of the first floor of the building, upgraded electrical throughout the building, improvements to the front meeting room, and new carpeting and painting throughout much of the areas. FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

On the road to Emmaus, Jesus met Cleopas and his friend along the way as they were leaving Jerusalem. Leaving Jerusalem was symbolic of turning away from God. Jesus didn't abandon them but He walked with them on their journey and shared with them that He was with them, rose from the dead, and gave their hearts a great sense of hope. Our modern world has challenges and obstacles to faith where many people struggle. We are not called to lose hope but to engage people on the journey. Pope Francis talks about accompanying people on their journey of faith – that is exactly what Jesus did on the road to Emmaus.

Parents of course have challenges in raising their children that are unprecedented – access to digital media, overprogrammed schedules, increased secularism, and constant traveling. Many of us are aware of Mark Wahlberg and his commitment to our catholic faith. He has had to live out his faith in the middle of a hectic schedule in Hollywood and dealing with a very secular environment. In an interview on the TODAY/NBC morning show during Ash Wednesday, Mr. Wahlberg gave the following advice on raising his children in the faith:

"I want them to gravitate to it in a very natural way. I want them to understand that Dad has to start the day by getting on his hands and his knees, and no matter where I am, the priority on Sunday is to go to church; so to be able to do those things and just see them — hopefully, they will say, 'Well, okay, there's got to be something there' and let them do it on their own."

He went on to say in another interview:

"I think, for parents and kids, just communicating with each other, being honest about how you feel, especially kids being able to communicate their feelings. ... When you see kids are dealing with their suffering and having to keep things inside, that should be accepted and embraced, no matter what. That was a very difficult thing. ... You know, there's one Judge. And we're all sinners. We're all weak in the flesh. And we all have made mistakes. But we want to encourage people ..."

Accompanying people, especially family members, is a challenge. Living out our faith was not meant to be easy. Keep in mind that at the end of the day, our Catholic faith is not an institution but a relationship with Jesus Christ and the Church that He instituted. Be an instrument and let the Lord do the work. He will open our hearts in the breaking of the bread.
