MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of April 24, 2023, we have received \$201,565.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. To date, we have spent \$172,745.40 on renovations including an enlarged office for the Director of Religious Education, several enlarged rooms for youth gatherings, new HVAC throughout both sides of the first floor of the building, upgraded electrical throughout the building, improvements to the front meeting room, and new carpeting and painting throughout much of the areas. More renovations to the Family and Youth Center side are planned in the future. Thank you to all those who continue to contribute to this Appeal.



Dear Friends,

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday, the traditional day for First Holy Communion! As sheep willingly follow their own shepherd, whose voice they recognize and who calls them by name, we find ourselves willing to follow the Lord Jesus, for we know His voice and He calls us each by name.

Peter echoes the words of John the Baptist in the first reading; "Repent and be baptized," though he can also tell people that they will receive the Holy Spirit. In his letter, he encourages us to look to Christ as an example when we suffer for doing what is right and good.

In the Gospel, Jesus, the Good Shepherd, describes himself as the gate through which we can find life abundant and eternal. Remain close to Jesus as together we await the day of His Second Coming in Glory!

After several visits to the cardiologist and a few tests, it has been determined that I need a mitral valve replacement. As I get older, the repercussions of adolescent Hodgkin's lymphoma have taken its toll. The date for the surgery is May 11. All necessary preparations for the steady and ongoing pastoral ministry and administration of the parish have been arranged.

I will be in hospital for a week and then in rehabilitation for 4 weeks. Hoping all goes well, I will be home and ready to resume fulltime work by mid-June. Of course, that's my hope.

Please pray for the success of this surgery and know that I will offer these days for your intentions. As I have been told by many of my friends, "You're not getting any younger!" I don't know what they mean, but I will do my best!

I would be grateful for your prayers through Our Lady of Lourdes and Padre Pio, who are my close friends and intercessors in this time of need. As Peter says in 1 Peter 5: 5b-14: "Cast all your worries upon Him because He cares for you."

IN OUR PARISH

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

During the height of the pandemic, people were not permitted to attend Mass for a few months. One of the other great spiritual travesties during this time was that many health care institutions prevented clergy from giving sacraments (eucharist, confession, anointing of the sick) to people that were preparing for death. It is very important for the church to promote these sacraments as we receive divine grace leading us to eternal salvation. The book of James states: "Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters (priests) of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint [him] with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven."

Anointing of the sick can be given to anyone experiencing illness, even if it is not life threatening. The special grace of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick has as its effects:

- the uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his/her own good and that of the whole Church.
- the strengthening, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age.
- the forgiveness of sins, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of penance.
- the restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his/her soul.
- the preparation for passing over to eternal life" (CCC 1532).

If there is a possibility that death is near, the priest may administer the Apostolic Blessing as an indulgence for the "remission of temporal punishment due to sin". The Apostolic Blessing makes the anointing of the sick, last rites.

Please do not wait until the last moments to reach out to the parish for this special grace. If you have a loved one in the parish that is not able to get to church, please contact the Parish Office or the local parish so that pastoral care can be provided to the homebound. Our Savior gave us a church where we can administer divine grace in a physical manner.
