

MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of April 16, 2023, we have received \$201,460.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. To date, we have spent \$172,745.40 on renovations including an enlarged office for the Director of Religious Education, several enlarged rooms for youth gatherings, new HVAC throughout both sides of the first floor of the building, upgraded electrical throughout the building, improvements to the front meeting room, and new carpeting and painting throughout much of the areas. More renovations to the Family and Youth Center side are planned in the future. Thank you to all those who continue to contribute to this Appeal.

IN OUR PARISH

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

As we begin the month of May, we know that this month is dedicated to Mary, the Mother of Jesus. When Mary found out that she would give birth to our Savior, she exclaimed "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior." Because she is the Mother of Jesus she also takes the role as our spiritual mother. We know from scripture that she would share with Jesus the needs of others, recalling specifically the need for more wine at the wedding at Cana in the gospel of John.

St. Louis de Montfort stated "If, then, we establish solid devotion to our Blessed Lady, it is only to establish more perfect devotion to Jesus Christ, and to provide an easy and secure means for finding Jesus Christ". He goes on to say "Satan, being proud, suffers infinitely more from being beaten and punished by a little and humble handmaid of God, and her humility humbles him more than the Divine power; and, secondly, because God has given Mary such a great power against the devils, that, as they have often been obliged to confess, in spite of themselves, by the mouths of the possessed, they fear one of her sighs for a soul more than the prayers of all the Saints, and one of her menaces against them more than all other torments."

We know that our Catholic faith is very Marian in its spirituality, that is one of the pillars and identifying marks of Catholicism. As a priest, I love to drive by a house and see a statue of the Blessed Mother in the front yard. If you do not have a statue of Our Lady, consider getting a statue at your house, or put one outside the door of your apartment/condo. When people see an image of Our Lady, they identify this with our Catholic Faith. Please also consider incorporating the rosary into your prayer life this month. If you do not pray the rosary regularly, consider saying one decade (an Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's and a Glory Be) daily during the month of May.








Come out and join the CCA for a night filled with fun, family, and baseball as our National League Champions take on the Chicago Cubs!


