





MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of May 7, 2023, we have received \$201,875.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. To date, we have spent \$172,745.40 on renovations including an enlarged office for the Director of Religious Education, several enlarged rooms for youth gatherings, new HVAC throughout both sides of the first floor of the building, upgraded electrical throughout the building, improvements to the front meeting room, and new carpeting and painting throughout much of the areas. FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROTT

On Saturday May 20th, the Archdiocese of Philadelphia ordained 7 men to the priesthood. This past year, they served as transitional deacons to our parishes. Please keep Fr. Anthony Albanese, Fr. Shane Flanagan, Fr. Randall J. Kraft, Fr. Phong Le, Fr. Kenneth Omeke, Fr. John Okpara, and Fr. Wesly L. Taveras in your prayers. This is a gift to our diocese that we have this many priests getting ordained during this time!

The priest acts in the person of Christ as head of the church to dispense God's grace to the world especially through the sacraments. During the Sacrament of Holy Orders, priests are "signed with a special character and are conformed to Christ the Priest in such a way that they can act in the person of Christ the Head". (*Presbyterorum ordinis* 2) Remember that each priest was ordained by a bishop and the bishops represent a direct, uninterrupted line of continuity from the first Apostles of Jesus Christ. Our Church has a very important visible and physical component that is necessary for sharing God's invisible grace.

Pope Benedict XVI said that "the function of the clergy is essential and irreplaceable in announcing the Word and celebrating the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist. ... For this reason, it is vital to ask the Lord to send workers for His harvest; and it is necessary that priests express joy in their faithfulness to their identity."

We all need the ministry that only the Priesthood of Jesus Christ can offer. We thank God for the gift of our new clergy.




