MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of May 30, 2023, we have received \$202,490.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. 


THE FEAST OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS
