



BRIEF FINANCIAL UPDATE

As we near the close of another fiscal year, I wanted to thank you for your response to our many financial requests, not only for this year but for the past several years. Everyone has been very generous, especially through Covid and the subsequent challenging financial times. Because of your generosity, a lot of refurbishing has been done.

My financial goal has always been, together with the Parish Finance Council, threefold: 1) Capital Projects, 2) Replenish Savings, and 3) Pay off the Debt. In Lent of 2018, I instituted the 3 Shore Up the Future Appeals. If you recall, Year 1 was to finance the repaying of the campus parking lot. We successfully raised \$124,924.00, the cost amounted to \$193,748.50 and the balance of \$68,824.50 came from Savings. Year 2 was to replace the HVAC system in church. Although we raised \$139,264.50, the scope of the work became more extensive than originally anticipated. Also, this was during the height of the Pandemic. The monies donated have been set aside in an interest-bearing account and, along with funds in the Archdiocesan Heritage of Faith Campaign, will be utilized when we are able to proceed with this project.

Year 3's goal was to make renovations to the Parish Office building, including the creation of a Family and Youth Center in the former convent side of the building. Although additional renovations are planned for the future, the renovations already completed total \$172,745.40. To date, we have received donations totaling \$203,005.50. The excess of \$30,260.10 will be put aside for those future renovations. We plan to hold an Open House in the fall to provide everyone with an opportunity to see these renovations.

I am "officially" closing the Year 3 Appeal as of June 30, 2023. Any donations made after this date to the Shore Up the Future Fund, will be saved for the Church Sanctuary project that I mentioned to you from the pulpit and in "The Providence" newsletter that was in last week's bulletin. Additional copies of the newsletter are available at the exits of the church, in the parish office, as well as on our website.

One of the responsibilities as pastor is to make sure the campus and its buildings are secure and well maintained. I appreciate very much your contributions that make this possible. Thank you for your generosity and goodwill. I think we can all be proud of what we have been given and what we can hand down to future generations.



MDP SHORE UP THE FUTURE

As of June 26, 2023, we have received \$203,060.50 in donations from 229 families for our 2020 Year 3 Challenge – renovations to the Parish Offices and creation of our Family and Youth Center. To date, we have spent \$172,745.40 on renovations including an enlarged office for the Director of Religious Education, several enlarged rooms for youth gatherings, new HVAC throughout both sides of the first floor of the building, upgraded electrical throughout the building, improvements to the front meeting room, and new carpeting and painting throughout much of the areas. More renovations to the Family and Youth Center side are planned in the future. Thank you to all those who continue to contribute to this Appeal.

SEMINARY CAMPAIGN

Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary, the oldest Catholic institution of higher learning in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, is calling on you to help with *Building Our Future*. As the seminary's relocation to Lower Gwynedd Township is fully underway, plans include renovating the existing buildings and constructing new buildings. This new location will guarantee and secure our commitment to forming new priests with an exceptional educational experience. Establishing an endowment is also vital so the seminary will lessen its dependence on annual giving and ensure the long-term sustainability of the mission.




