MISSION CO-OP APPEAL

Next weekend, our second collection will be for the Mission Co-op Appeal. This year our giving will support Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The following is information on their community:



As an international community of women, the Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the United States rejoice in the gift that is ours to be interracial and multicultural in membership.

In addition to the United States, where our first ministry began in Philadelphia in 1926, our United States sisters hail from China, Columbia, Cuba, England, Peru, Taiwan, Spain and Vietnam! Locally, in Philadelphia, the Sisters assist parishioners at local parishes, teach and work at local universities, represent the Handmaids to UNANIMA [an international coalition of Women Religious], operate the

Mission Center and coordinate the international digital network for the movement for Justice, Peace and the Integrity of Creation.

The ministries which will receive the support from the generosity of the faithful of Philadelphia are:

FIAT- El Salvador Mission, where the Handmaids provide housing, food programs, clean water projects, education and literacy programs for the village and surrounding area. We accompany volunteer groups and facilitate a transformative experience for the volunteers and people of El Salvador through cultural immersion, food and building projects, prayer and reflection.

The Handmaid community in Miami, Florida – was established in 1975 in response to an influx of Cuban refugees. Members of our community in Miami aid the homeless population at a homeless shelter, offer legal counsel to immigrants and refugees, collaborate in parish religious education programs and missions, and lead young adult groups through prayer and counseling services.

BISHOP KENRICK CLASS OF 1973 REUNION

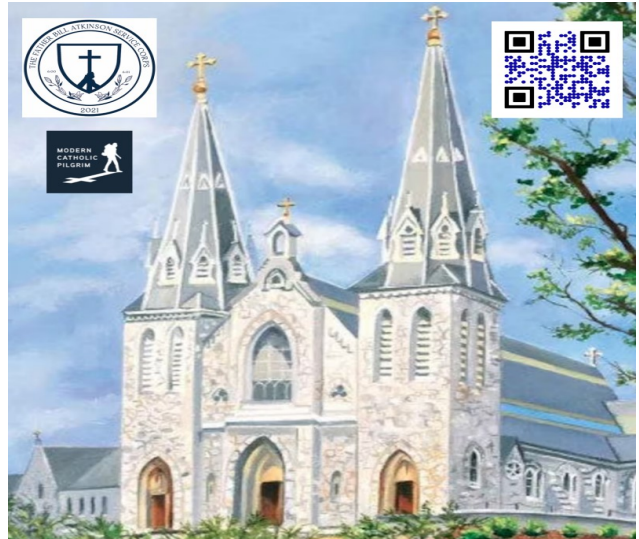
