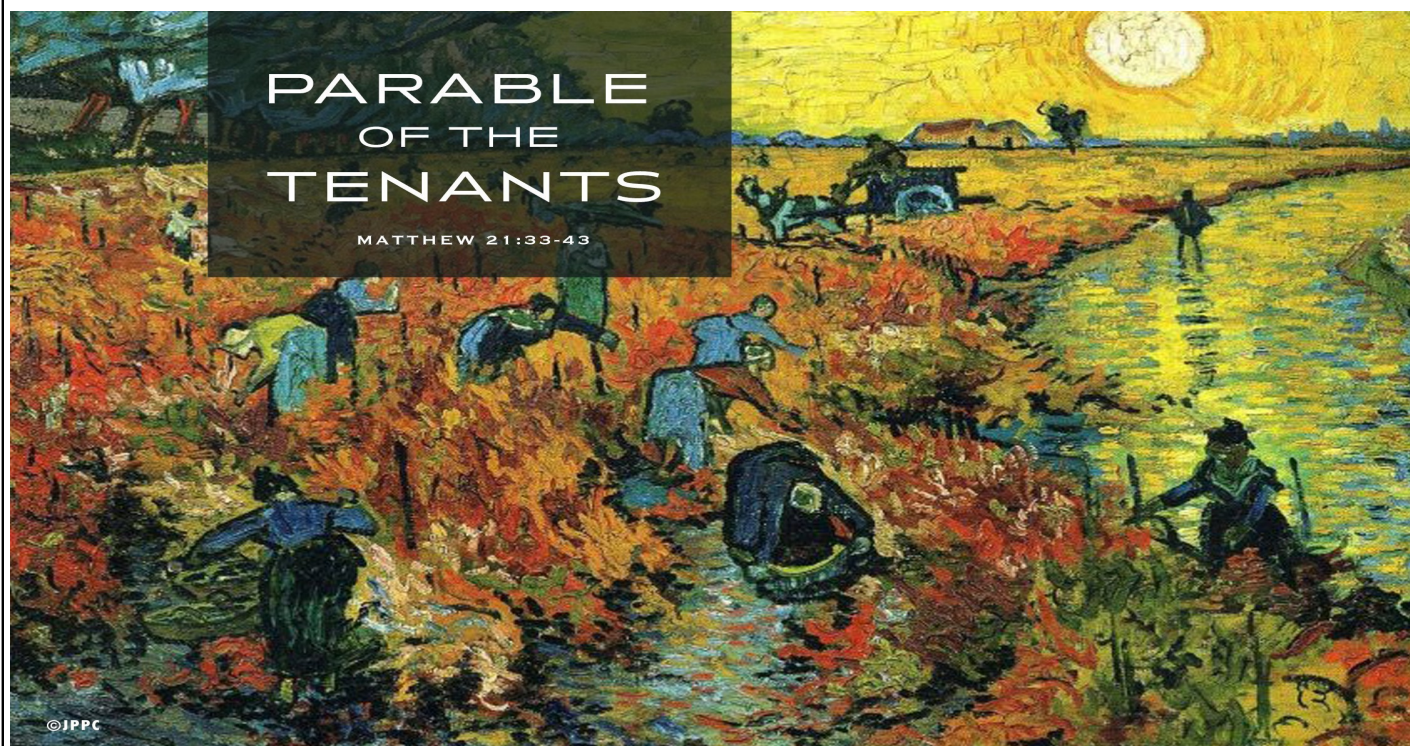

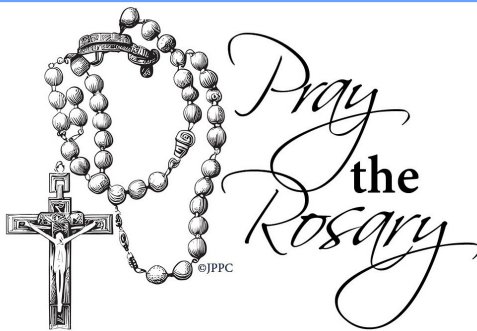


Catechists Needed!

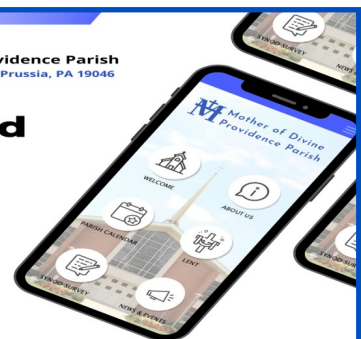

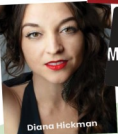
