- Kielbasa for \$9 per pound from Czerw's in Port Richmond

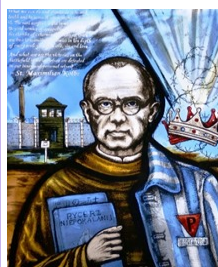
Blessed opłatki (Polish Christmas wafer) are also available for a free will donation.
