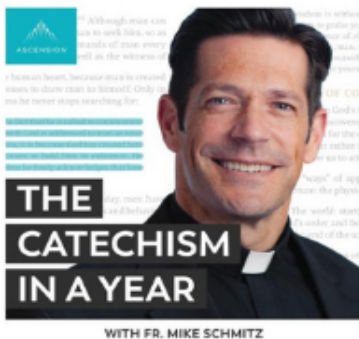


Come join the “Millions of Monicas” prayer group on Tuesday evenings in the Church at 6:15pm.
