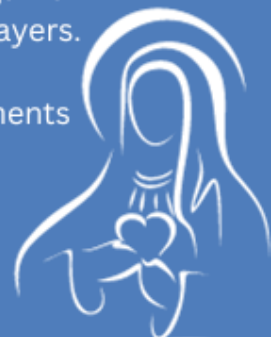
The Legion of Mary invites you to attend a Frank Duff Prayer Meeting
