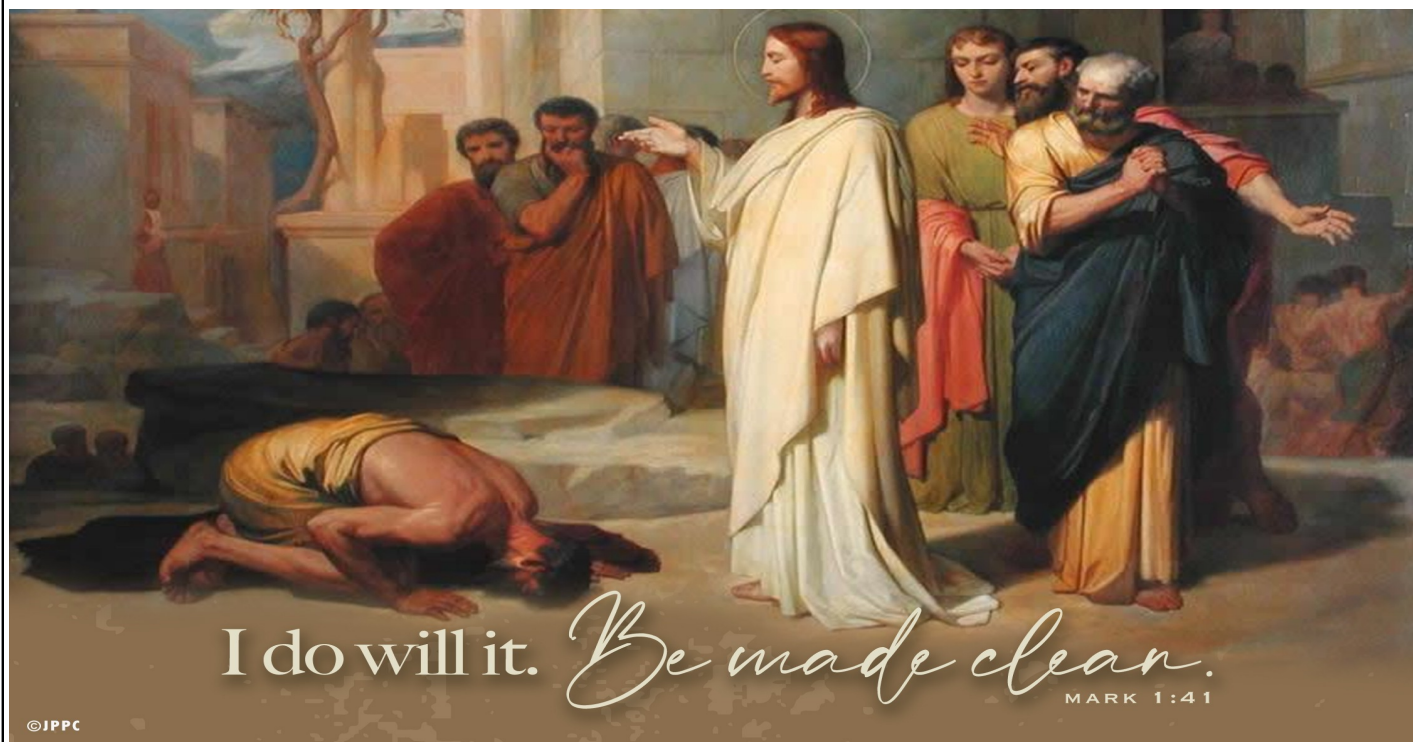

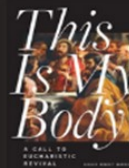

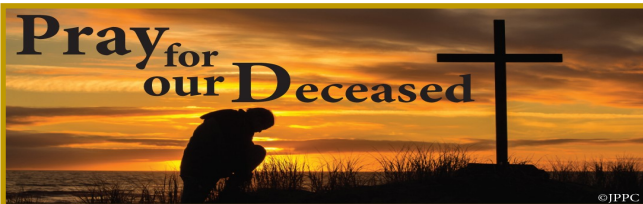

## AROUND THE ARCHDIOCESE

### IT'S THE CIRCLE OF LIFE
