Please join us after the 8:00 am Mass for coffee and refreshments before the meeting in McGrory Hall.

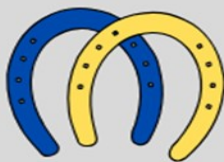

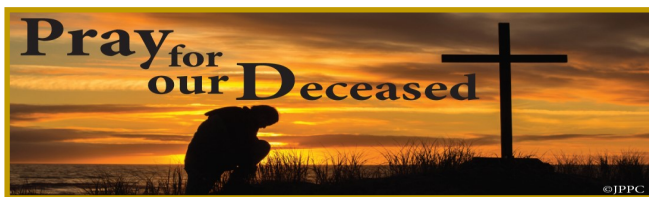

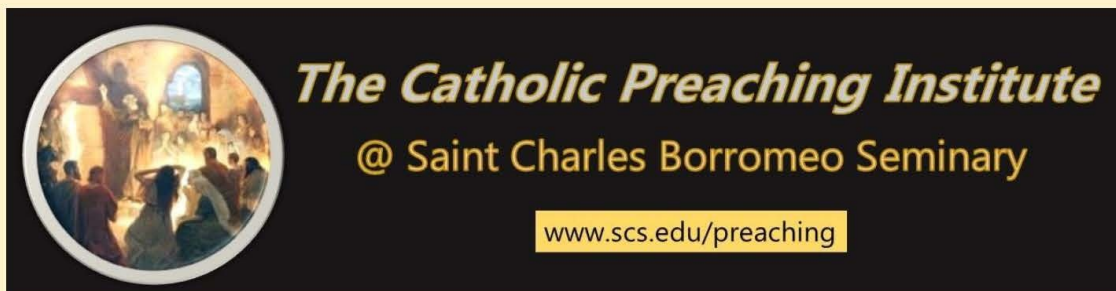
