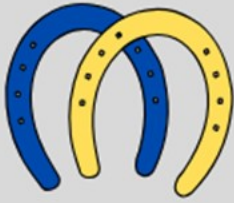

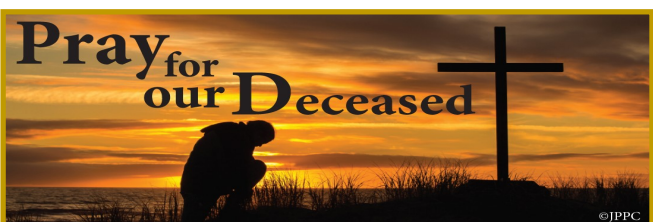
A PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS
