#### **IN OUR PARISH**

#### **CHURCH HVAC UPDATE**

At long last, the new HVAC unit has been ordered for the Church! This new 40-ton unit will be powered by gas, eliminating our need for oil. Jordahl Engineering and Mechanical LLC is the contractor hired for this work. They will work along with PABEC Systems Inc., who will do the electrical work needed.

Prior to the demolition of the existing equipment, asbestos will be abated by Bristol Environmental. The boiler room will be properly sealed and isolated before the asbestos removal begins. The asbestos removal work will be overseen and the air monitored by Pennoni Associates Inc., a professional environmental management company. At the present time, the asbestos abatement is scheduled to begin on May 27. This work will take 7 - 8 normal work days.

Demolition of the existing equipment will begin immediately upon the completion of the asbestos abatement. The 40-ton unit will be installed, ductwork from the new unit to the existing ductwork in the boiler room will be supplied, and other cutting, patching, and support work will be performed. A new gas line will be run to a new meter. Final work to provide a comfortable air balanced system is expected to be completed in mid-July.

If the asbestos abatement work can commence earlier than scheduled, the project timeline will change. We should, however, plan on no air conditioning from mid-May until mid-July.

When we first budgeted for the replacement of the Church HVAC, back in June of 2020, we expected the total cost to be \$200,000. We now expect the project to cost between \$295,000 and \$325,000. Our present funds for this project follow:

Our goal is to be able to support our whole community, including those who are unable to make it to church at this time, but we need everyone's help in order to be aware of these individuals!






#### **STUDENT CORNER**
