

Hello! My name is Dave Snyder, and I'm elated to start serving this amazing community as your Director of Music Ministry. I have already felt so welcome in such a short time, and I feel like that speaks to this wonderful community as a whole.

I'm from Ridley Park in Delaware County, where I attended St. Madeline-St. Rose School and Cardinal O'Hara High School. My love for music began at St. Madeline Parish, where I would occasionally cantor and play soprano saxophone at Mass, and every other time sitting next to my Mom who would sing loudly and off key in the pews. These early experiences nurtured my passion for liturgical music and set the foundation for my future endeavors. I live in the Swedeland section of Upper Merion with my beautiful wife Colleen, and our incredible girls, Cecilia and Arden, soon turning 5 and 3 respectively.

Though my journey began in the church, I come to this work from a theatre background. I hold a degree from Syracuse University and have spent my career as a Music Director and Piano/Voice Teacher. I have 9 years of experience as a Lead Piano and Voice Teacher at Meridee Winters School of Music and another 9 years as Music Director of the Wolf Performing Arts Center in Bryn Mawr. In addition to serving this community, I am currently also the Co-Director of Theater at Springside Chestnut Hill Academy in Philadelphia, where I have served for 10 years, collaborating on productions that range from Shakespearian plays to modern musicals and fostering the artistic growth of young performers.

I am passionate about blending traditional and contemporary styles to create moving worship experiences. We will play hymns that you may not have heard before, rotate Mass settings, and incorporate exciting new and exciting worship music by some incredible composers. My approach is to ensure that the music ministry not only enhances the liturgical celebrations but also brings the parish community closer together. I believe in the power of music to inspire faith, accentuate the beauty of the Liturgy, and foster a deep sense of community. Although I don't play the organ yet, I am confident it won't take long to get my feet under me. It's coming along, and I look forward to integrating it into our worship services in the coming weeks.

I am eager to meet and collaborate with each member of our parish community. As a former youth theatre music director, I encourage you to sing loud and with your whole breath and body, from your feet to your head. All voices should be welcome here, and as much as I love the sound of my own voice, the beauty of this work is in yours. If you love singing, I encourage you to take a seat with us and sing with our choir. Together, we can share in the joy of music, enrich our worship experiences, and strengthen our bonds of faith. I look forward to helping make every liturgical celebration at Mother of Divine Providence a profound expression of faith and worship.






