

Saint Frances Cabrini: The Movie and the Saint

This year has been a mixed bag for the devotees of the first Catholic saint from the United States, Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini. In March 2024, a movie entitled Cabrini about her illustrious missionary activities was released which renewed the public awareness of American Catholics about her. At the end of the Spring 2024 academic term, the only university named after her, located in Radnor, PA was closed. What can we make of this paradox?

Critically reviewing the new movie, Cabrini, can provide us with some answers to the puzzle. In other words, drawing from the assumptions and the obvious, and providing some details on the omitted parts of her life in the movie could help us have a greater appreciation of Mother Cabrini's mission, her importance in American culture, and the value of her Catholic educational program.

You are invited to a talk entitled, Saint Frances Cabrini: The Movie and the Saint, on Tuesday, August 13 at 7:15 PM in the MDP Parish Offices. Seeing the movie is NOT a prerequisite for attending the talk, although it may be helpful.

The talk will be given by Reverend Fidelis Olokunboro, PhD who is in residence at MDP. Fr. Fidelis served on the faculty of Cabrini University from 08/2022 until the closing this Summer.


