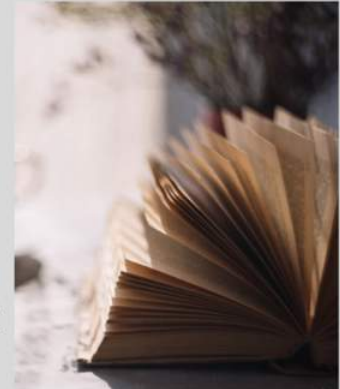

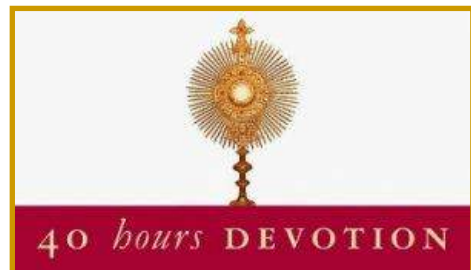

MDP Spring 2025 Grief Support

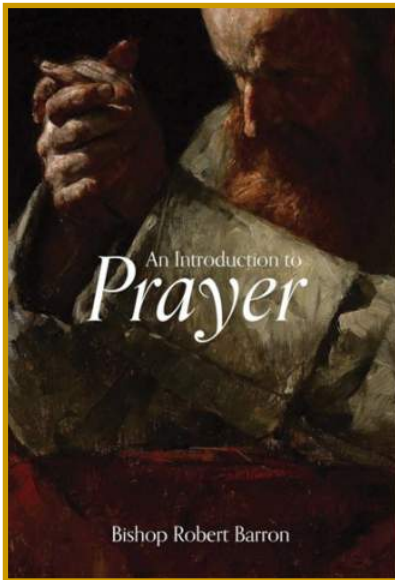
