Notes to Operating Report for the period July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024

(1) Sunday Collections – The Sunday collection is our responsibility as good stewards of God’s bounty and abiding love. It provides the necessary means to fund the ordinary budget of our Parish. By actively participating in the Sunday collection, each parishioner is taking ownership of our sacred space, this sanctuary consecrated to the worship of God in King of Prussia. The Annual Ordinary Budget for Mother of Divine Providence Parish is \$1.1 million. This does not include emergency expenditures. The parish does not get subsidized. Your weekly contributions and special donations contribute to the extraordinary work we do here in pastoral outreach, liturgical and formational ministries.

(2) Socials and Donations, Net – The Community Carnival held on September 14, 15, 16, 2023 netted \$67,264 and the Christmas Craft Fair and Bazaar held on November 18, 2023 netted \$14,356. The Athletic Association contributes \$5,000 to the parish annually. The remainder of the funds included in Socials and Donations came from votive candle offerings, Memorial donations and general donations.

(3) Religious Education Programs do not include expenses for salary and benefits. Those expenses are included in the “Salaries of Other Lay Employees” and “Payroll Taxes and Fringe Benefits” expenses.

(4) Not included in the Operating Report:

- A Bequest of \$1,911.
- Donations received for the Shore Up the Future Appeal - \$31,567. This includes a \$10,000 donation from the MDP Knights of Columbus.
- Donations received for the Parish Fund - \$48,244. (Used to fund loan payments this year.)
- Donations received for the Endowment Fund for Catholic Education – \$2,260.
- Principal payments of \$40,337.31 paid to the Archdiocese of Philadelphia for the loan on the Parish Center. The original loan amount, obtained in April 2008, was \$1,230,000. The loan has now been paid in full!
- Replacement of the church HVAC - \$203,504. (85% of job)
- Balance of payment to St. Charles Borromeo Seminary for purchase of Nakashima Furniture for Church Sanctuary - \$37,500.
- Replacement of church sacristy roof - \$39,100.
- Mold remediation in rectory basement - \$43,950.
- Our parish’s charitable donations for local and worldwide needs (Catholic Relief Services, Mission Co-op, Operation Rice Bowl, etc.) via the 2nd Collections totaled \$32,353 and given via Poor Box donations totaled \$11,924.

The charitable contributions you make to MDP or other charities may not be providing you a tax benefit. Making those contributions using the **Qualified Charitable Distribution** concept from your IRA could provide substantial tax benefits if you are of Required Minimum Distribution age, 73.
