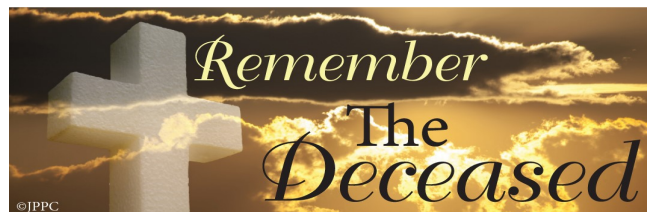


Come join the Saint Monica's Prayer Group Tuesday evenings in the Church at 6:15pm.
