Dear parishioners,

I thought it would be a good idea to give a brief introduction and tell you a little bit about myself as I begin my time as pastor of this parish. I am humbled and privileged to be assigned to Mother of Divine Providence and I am grateful for the hospitality and warm welcome I have received from parishioners, staff, and clergy.

I was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia in May of 2010. The homily at my first Mass was delivered by Father Martin Cioppi. This was because Father Cioppi had been my spiritual director since my first year in seminary. Father served me as a spiritual father during those crucial years of discernment and formation. He faithfully met with me once every three weeks to provide guidance and feedback as I engaged seminary formation. It is beyond a consolation to see many pictures of his serene and smiling face throughout the parish offices and Church.

I served at my first parish, St. Christopher in Somerton, for four years as parochial vicar. That was a parish that gave me a great deal of experience with all the activity surrounding a typical parish, Weddings, Funerals, Baptisms, School Masses, CYO, Seniors Citizen Clubs etc. When I left there, I was replaced by Father Sean English, who also just moved into the parish with me this week as he serves as vocations director for the Archdiocese. I look forward to his priestly presence being a blessing to the parish as well.

After four years at my first assignment I moved to College Campus Ministry. I spent nine years as Director of the Catholic Newman Center at West Chester University. During my time there I met many students who came from Mother of Divine Providence Parish and, because of my friendship with Father Cioppi, we sent a handful of our graduates to come and work at this Parish. This served as a nice connection between our Newman Center and the parish which produced many opportunities for me to visit the parish and become acquainted with it.

After nine years at West Chester, I was transferred to Temple University to serve as both chaplain there as well as pastor of the nearby Parish, St. Malachy on North 11th. Street. Both of those places proved to be sources of growth for me as they shaped my perspective on Church Mission and Evangelization.

After two short but transformative years in North Philly, I learned that I was being assigned here to Mother of Divine Providence. I look forward to seeing what God has in store for this Parish and to make that discovery alongside all of you as the people of God.

Thank you for your hospitality and I look forward to getting to know all of you in the coming weeks and months ahead.

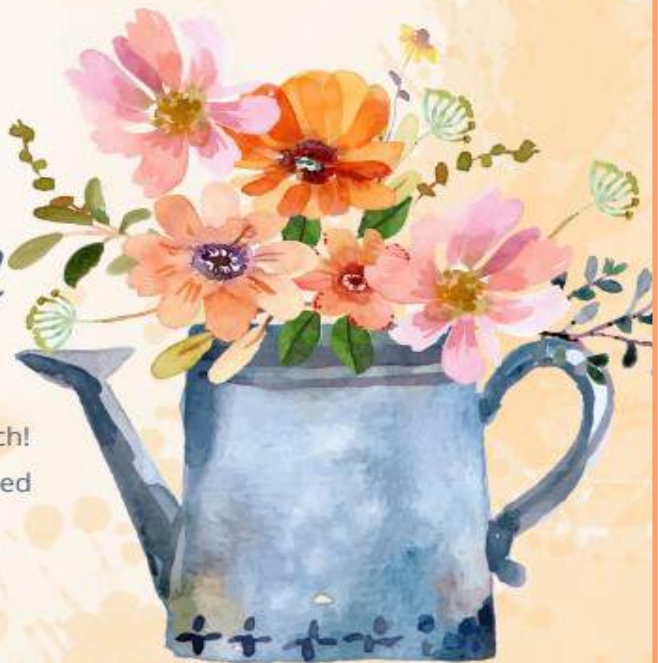

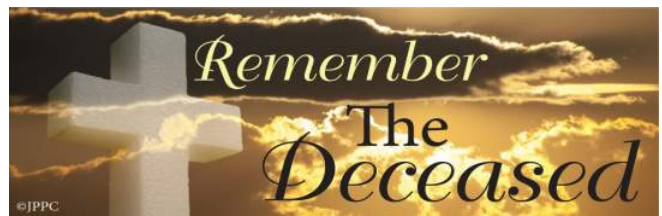
