However, the forgetfulness of who we are and/or who we are supposed to be, together with our daily distractions, challenge our souls and peace.

To learn from St. Augustine the process of remembering who we are and the process of Christian therapy to enjoy God's peace, we shall study and analyze his *Confessions*, especially Book I, Chapter 1, and Book X, Chapters 5-10, 23.

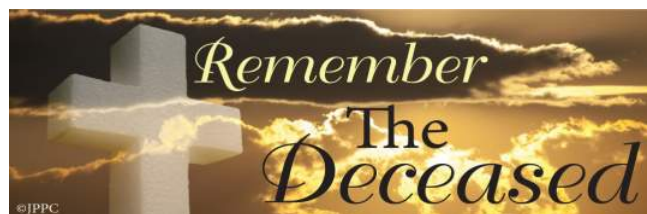


Come join the Saint Monica's Prayer Group Tuesday evenings in the Church at 6:15pm.
